

Welcome to Hope for the Future 2025. We are so pleased to share the evening with you and pleased that we have an opportunity to tell you a bit about the incredible impact of Hope Communities. It is a way for us to celebrate the thousands of people who have overcome obstacles and begun the journey towards achieving life goals for themselves and future generations – often going from homelessness or forcible displacement to stable housing, improved employment, and homeownership.

We are very proud to have served 4,592 individuals with customized programs and services last year. We provided services with skilled staff who speak 21 languages; offered enough fresh, culturally appropriate food to prepare more than 99,802 meals; provided direct employment assistance to over 2,000; worked with 352 kids; and served more people experiencing homelessness than ever before. It has been rewarding to see such transformational growth for the families we served across the region last year, made even more possible with the opening of a new office in Northglenn to better serve clients north of Denver.
